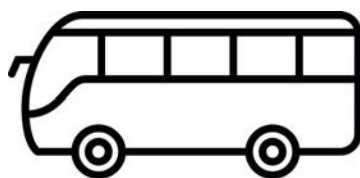

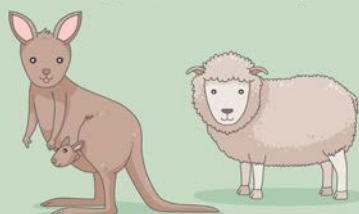

I do hope you all enjoyed the festive season and spent quality time with family and friends.

Please keep in your thoughts those people in Queensland who have suffered the effects of the very wet weather, those in Japan following the earthquake, and to all those suffering from the many war events occurring.

Did you and your family attend the Christmas functions? What a great day it was for those who attended the luncheon in the Chapel. Congratulations to all who assisted the many residents and families to have a great time. Thank you to all the lovely positive feedback received from people who attended.

There are some exciting things going to occur in and around the Home over the next 12 months. It's hoped that you'll all be involved in one way or another.

The major project for the year will be the filming of a documentary with Noni Hazelhurst assisting the discussion of the use of technology and robots in the aged care sector environment. I'll ensure you are all kept informed about the process of being involved. There's the necessary red tape to go through first.

For those visiting the Home we are developing undercover car parking. This project should be completed over the coming months. Grant money is assisting in meeting the cost of installing solar panels covering the car parks. The cost of electricity in the new future is going to increase, the use of solar will ensure our energy costs are reduced.

Over the coming weeks the draft Aged Care Act will be reviewed, and a revised version will go before parliament later in the year. If anyone would like to review the document or make comment, please feel free to go online to gain access to the site that allows you to read the whole document. If you wish to discuss the document, feel free to come and talk to me. This new Aged Care Acts is proposed to make entering the aged care sector easier and provides greater emphasis on the level of care expected for residents. There are even further controls and reporting placed on those who manage the aged care facilities and services.

Thankyou to everyone who joined us for the Winter Wonderland Family Christmas event in December.

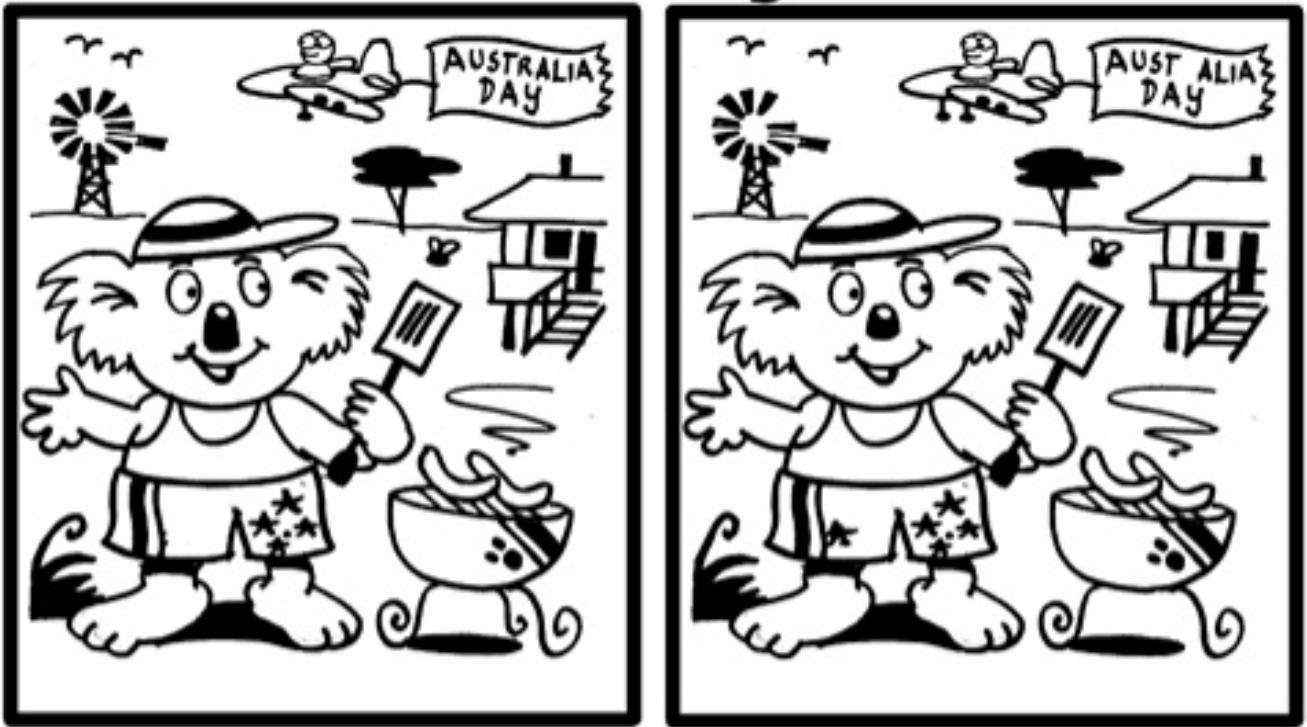

We had awesome feedback from residents and families. We hope to continue to provide beautiful events like

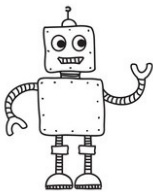


Australia Day Puzzle

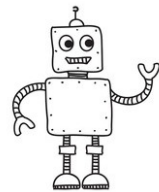

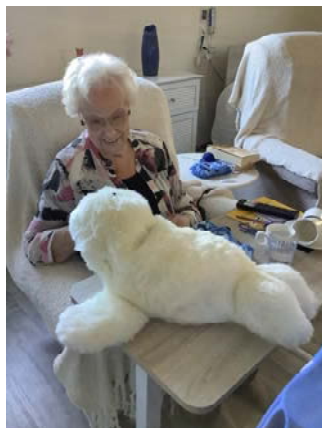

Robot Update



As you may have seen, a couple of new robots were trialed over Christmas. We will adjust the scheduling of the cleaning robots to reduce the chances of any incidents with residents. Please remember – the robots have many sensors so they can not run into anything – that includes people. Feel free to stand still, the robot will go around you. There will be another robot introduced in the coming weeks that is more interactive with people – its name is “Abbi”. This robot is very intelligent, speaks different languages, sings, answers any questions, and can demonstrate tai chi. I’m told residents will be able to establish a rapport with the robot – it can recognize residents and remember previous conversations.
