What a great outcome that has been achieved. During the first day of operation, the residents thoroughly enjoyed looking at all the objects from the past. At the same time enjoying a treat of scones and cream with a cup of tea. The smiles on their faces were priceless. With the developing requirement to have an Independent Advisory Committee I can now announce that we have been able to appoint Sherrie Boucher as the chairperson of that committee. Staff and residents will now be brought together on occasions throughout the year to review the outcomes of the services being provided and provide the TLH Board with recommendations of any changes. The TLH Board will provide written responses to all residents and the families.

Our current projects are on track and making good progress. The Nuriootpa Retirement Village – stage three is well underway. The planning for the Angaston Retirement Village is nearing completion. The sale of the land at Luther Court is nearing settlement. The TRL community center and refurbished Barossa Club area are making good headway to the finish date later this year. Work on the carpark and solar project continues.

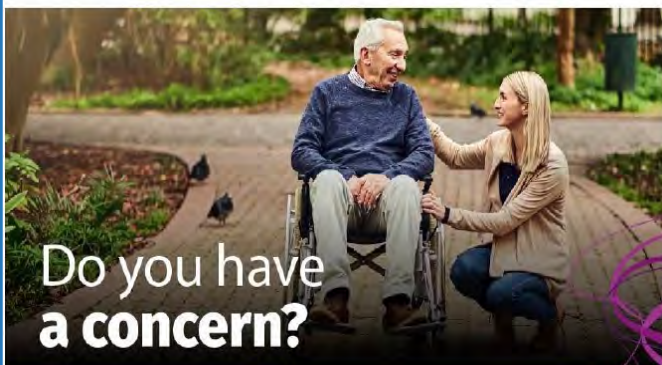

His entrenchment and dedication to the Hall and community led him to have the unofficial title of Mayor of Mt McKenzie.

Graham celebrated his 79th birthday on the 17th of December 2023 which was the day of the Christmas Show at the Hall. Last weekend, Mt McKenzie hall had its country rock outdoor night with funds going back into the maintenance of the hall. This event took over from the sherry party of the past.

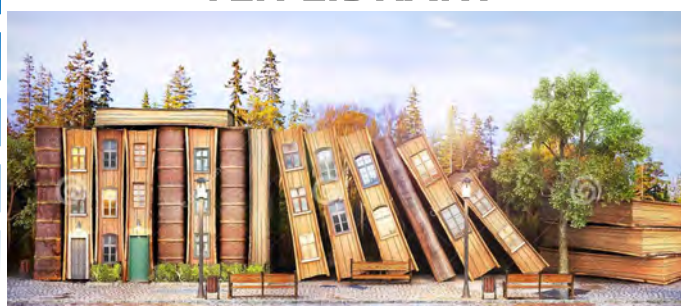
